Dear Middletown Parents,

The Middletown Township Preschool will remain a five-day per week program for the 2010-2011 School Year. Sessions are half-day either A.M. or P.M.

If a family meets the criteria for being Financially Eligible, the child will be placed in the program on a "First Come, First Serve" basis. The Federal Income Chart is used to measure financial eligibility.

Students whose families are interested in paying tuition (\$250/month) for the program are chosen through a lottery system. The lottery will be held at the March 24th Board of Education meeting. If your child's name is selected, you will be given instructions on registration. Although transportation is available for students placed by the preschool CST and for those who are financially eligible, transportation is not available for tuition students.

If you are interested in the Middletown Township Preschool Program, please complete the application found on the website, middletownk12.com; the August T. Miner Building; or any of the 12 elementary schools' main offices.
