## **-Cartooning Club - (Grades 3<sup>rd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup>)**

Join The Community YMCA' first **"Y-Cartooning"** club after school at New Monmouth Elementary exclusively designed for kids in the 3<sup>rd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> grades. The club will operate for a period of **8 weeks** and **1 hour & 10 min** long each week after school.

**Y-Cartooning** is a unique club that focuses on the art of cartooning. It supports critical thinking, problem finding and solving, and have students engaged in experimenting in a meaningful design context. Creating a story bored requires thinking of an overall idea, then writing/drawing a script with actions and dialogue and transferring that idea, programming them into the blocks on a computer. Create new worlds and learn new media and techniques. Students will spend time both working with drawing tools and other mixed media materials as well as in the computer lab bringing their cartoons to life.

The **Y-Cartooning** club sets the platform for children to develop a language of expression while enhancing self-awareness and self-management skills by integrating the art of cartooning to achieve social and academic success.
