For the 2010-2011 school year, Middletown High Schools are offering 11th and 12th grade students an exciting way to satisfy their Health and Physical Education requirement. It is called an Individual Learning Opportunity (ILO) in Health and Physical Education. This program will enable students to satisfy their Health and Physical Education requirement outside of the school day, either through participation in school sponsored activities, private activities, or a combination of the two.
