

Revised Middle School Honor Roll & High Honor Roll Criteria

CURRENT HIGH SCHOOL CRITERIA for Honor Roll:

High Schools North/South recognize their students' scholastic achievement by placing their names on the High / Honor Roll.

- Qualifications for the **High Honor Roll** — A GPA of 3.75 with no grade lower than an 80.
- Qualifications for the **Honor Roll** — A GPA of 3.25 with no grade lower than an 80.

CURRENT MIDDLE SCHOOL CRITERIA for Honor Roll:

After report cards are issued each marking period, students may qualify for academic honors. To arrive at these honors, the number of quality points are totaled. Each percentile grade is equivalent to quality points as indicated below:

100-95	=	9 quality points
94-90	=	8 quality points
89-85	=	7 quality points
84-80	=	6 quality points

79-75	=	5 quality points
74-70	=	4 quality points
69-65	=	2 quality points
64 or below	=	0 quality points

Qualifications for High Honor Roll are as follows:

- Nothing lower than a B for the High Honor Roll and 54 quality points for a 7 subject student; 62 quality points for an 8 subject student.

Middle School Academic Honor Cards are awarded to students who qualify following each marking period.

Qualifications for Honor Roll are as follows:

- Nothing lower than a B for Honor Roll and 42 quality points for a 7 subject student; 48 quality points for an 8 subject student.

Courses that are offered once a week do not count toward High Honor Roll and Honor Roll.

Philosophies and Notable Changes to the Criteria:

- Standard closer to the high school criteria and that of other middle schools.
- Elimination of the point system.
- Elimination of letter grade and alignment to numerical grading system.
- Allowing for an individual course grades to be lower than the minimum for high honor roll.
- Simpler criteria to determine students who qualify.

REVISED MIDDLE SCHOOL CRITERIA for HONOR ROLL:

(Based on having reviewed the criteria used in our high schools as well as that used by several districts for their middle schools as well as the impact statistics run using prior grades for comparison):

After report cards are issued each marking period, students may qualify for academic honors. To qualify for either High Honor Roll or Honor Roll, a student is required to meet the following criteria indicated below:

Qualifications for High Honor Roll each marking period are as follows:

- 92% in ALL classes or 92% in all but one class with no more than one grade between 85 and 91.

Qualifications for Honor Roll each marking period are as follows:

- 80% in all classes.
