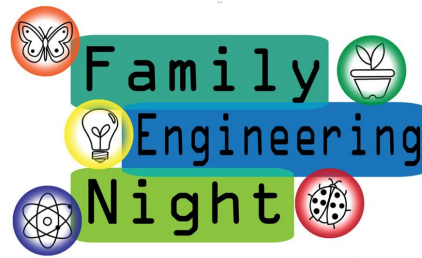

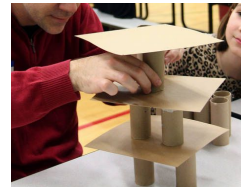
Who Should Come to Family Engineering Night?
