Promotion Ceremony

The Thorne Middle School 8th grade Promotion Ceremony will be held at Monmouth University, West Long Branch, on Monday, June 17th at 4:15 p.m. Directions will be posted on the Thorne website. Students must report to Monmouth University by 3:30 p.m. Please give yourself at least one hour of travel time and keep in mind summer and unexpected traffic delays.

DISMISSAL

- All students will be dismissed at 12:15 p.m.

ADMISSION

- Each eighth grade student will be entitled to twelve (12) invitations. The invitation serves as a ticket for the ceremony. Graduates do not need a ticket. Please feel free to check with other families that are not using all 12 invitations if you require additional invitations. If you have extenuating circumstances we need to be aware of feel free to contact the main office.
- Handicapped seating will be available.
- Invitations will be distributed during homeroom. **The date of distribution will be determined at a later date.**

DRESS CODE

- All graduates have purchased a traditional graduation gown. Distribution of gowns will take place through homeroom, date to be determined. Students must wear appropriate attire: Dress shirt and tie, dress pants and appropriate dresses, and dress shoes. (No clogs, sneakers, flip flops, etc.)

CEREMONY

- Students will report to Monmouth University by 3:30 p.m. sharp!
- Directions will be posted on Thorne's website.
- The ceremony will last approximately one hour.
- Please hold applause until all names are called.
- Please note that the arena is air-conditioned.
- Only students who have completed graduation requirements and have participated in all rehearsals will participate in the ceremony. Students must have turned in all Thorne property, i.e., chrome books, library books, locks, etc. or pay for such items or they will not receive their diplomas. (checks made payable to: Thorne Middle School).
- **Diplomas will be given out on Tuesday, June 18th.**

We consider this ceremony to be very serious since it marks a milestone in the lives of our children and would appreciate your respectful participation, as an audience member, so that every one of our fine students gets the recognition they deserve.
