

# DESCRIPTION OF PERFORMANCE BANDS: LINKIT BENCHMARK ASSESSMENTS FORMS A, B, C

## Exceeding

**Forms A/B:** Student is projected to be above grade level expectations after a full-year of instruction.

**Form C:** Student is above grade level expectations after a full-year of instruction.

## Meeting

**Forms A/B:** Student is projected to be on grade level after a full-year of instruction.

**Form C:** Student is on grade level after a full-year of instruction.

## Bubble

**Forms A/B:** Student is projected to be on the border of meeting grade level expectations and approaching grade level expectations after a full-year of instruction.

**Form C:** Student is on the border of meeting grade level expectations and approaching grade level expectations after a full-year of instruction.

## Approaching

**Forms A/B:** Student is projected to be below grade level expectations, but making progress toward grade level expectations after a full-year of instruction.

**Form C:** Student is below grade level expectations, but is making progress toward grade level expectations after a full-year of instruction.

## Partially Meeting

**Forms A/B:** Student is projected to only partially meet grade level expectations after a full-year of instruction.

**Form C:** Student is only partially meeting grade level expectations after a full-year of instruction.

## Not Meeting

**Forms A/B:** Student is projected to not meet grade level expectations after a full-year of instruction.

**Form C:** Student is not meeting grade level expectations after a full-year of instruction.

**IMPORTANT TO NOTE:** The performance bands for Forms A and B take into consideration that all standards have not been fully instructed at the time of assessment. These bands predict end-of-year performance with a high-rate of reliability.
