- Brookdale Community College in Lincroft, NJ has recently renewed its partnership with Jersey Central Power and Light (JCP&L).
- The program consists of job training for high-wage, in demand jobs as line workers and substations electricians for the electric utility industry.

The Details

- Classroom work includes technical coursework, technology labs, business-specific courses, and general education courses of English, Math, Economics, and Interpersonal Communication.
- Hands-On Experiences are done at one of FirstEnergy's training centers and includes a compensated 10-week evaluated field experience, which takes place following the second semester.
