PFLAG is a nonprofit organization that aims to provide support for families and allies of lesbian, gay, bisexual, and transgender (LGBT) individuals, and LGBT individuals themselves.

Jersey Shore PFLAG is a local chapter of PFLAG International, which envisions a world where diversity is celebrated and all people are respected and valued.

How does it work?

- Formed in 2004 and serves Monmouth and Ocean counties in New Jersey
- The main role is to host monthly support meetings that provide comfort, information, and discussion in a safe, confidential, and nonjudgmental environment.
- Sponsorship of various special events throughout the year, including panel discussions, training seminars for schools and workplaces, youth dances, and more.
