Play "Be A Mind Reader." Think of a number between a stated range of numbers. Your child will guess a number based on your "clues." After your child has guessed your number, you get to be the "mind reader!"

Adult: I'm thinking of a number from 1-100.

Child: 50

Child: 32

Adult: The number has 3 tens and some ones.

Adult: **Great job!**

Child: 37

Adult: The number has less than 7 ones.
