The 12th Grade Family Life course is designed to help students develop the skills and attitudes necessary to achieve and maintain lifelong health and fitness. Students will review stages in human development and relationships from adolescence through adulthood. This will include both male and female reproductive systems, sexually transmitted infections, and methods of birth control including abstinence as well as pregnancy and childbirth, parenting, and teen pregnancy.
