SPS 6106 PRACTICUM I CONTRACT

The Georgian Court University School Psychology Program hereby enters into an agreement with

Heather Basmagy and the Middletown Township pursuant to a school psychology practicum.
school district

The period of appointment is from September 2023 to December 2023, or until completion of a minimum of 40 hours. Typically, students spend at least ½ day per week at the practicum site (more, if necessary, to complete the tasks listed below).

This practicum entails shadowing a school psychologist and completing one consultation/intervention project. Through this consultation project, the practicum student works individually with a general education or special education teacher in an indirect service delivery model to complete the following tasks:

Practicum Student

- 1) Identify a child in the teacher's class who is experiencing either academic or behavioral difficulties
- 2) Complete a systematic interview with the teacher to prioritize a specific problem for intervention
- 3) Conduct classroom (and other) observations, as necessary, to ensure that the specific problem is sufficiently understood.
- 4) Collect baseline data for the identified problem
- 5) Research evidenced-based interventions to present to the teacher for possible inclusion into a behavior or academic plan for the child
- 6) Collaborate with the teacher to construct an intervention plan
- 7) Assist the teacher, as necessary, in the implementation of this plan
- 8) Collect progress monitoring data to determine the effectiveness of the plan.
- 9) Observe the school psychologist in his/her day-to-day activities as appropriate.

The practicum student also will attend weekly, on-campus practicum classes conducted by university school psychology faculty.

Supervisor

1. The supervisor has the responsibility of expeditiously notifying the university supervisor of any concerns about the practicum student's performance that cannot be resolved in the placement setting.

2. The supervisor will provide opportunities for the practicum student to observe various school psychologist duties as appropriate.

School District

1. The school district will provide a safe and secure work environment and adequate, well-lighted office space that ensures confidentiality for completing assigned tasks.
2. The school district will enable the practicum student to meet training requirements, including providing the student access to members of the teaching staff who are willing to participate in this consultation-based practicum.

Georgian Court University

1. The GCU faculty practicum supervisor will assist the practicum student and the field supervisor in problem solving when the extern or the field supervisor reports an unresolved issue.
2. The GCU faculty practicum supervisor is responsible for assigning a grade to the practicum student.


This agreement shall be effective when executed by all parties.
